Allegany Arts Council Individual Artist Grant Application

The Allegany Arts Council is pleased to announce a new grant program for individual artists offering awards of up to \$2,000 to artists or artist teams who reside in, sell in, or create work in Allegany County, Maryland. The goal of the program is to support artists in the creation of new works. Funding may be used for the purchase of materials, rental of studio space, hiring of models, artist payments, or other project-specific expenses.

A final report outlining the use of grant funds must be submitted no later than one year after funds are distributed. The granting agency will supply a form for completion. Allegany Arts Council members will be given priority in application review.
